- 2) Children who are funded with Head Start or Preschool Special Needs dollars will not receive additional tuition assistance unless they have a need to extend to full day.
- 3) Children who are already funded with a combination of State Early Childhood Education Preschool slots *and* Publicly Funded Child Care are not eligible for additional Preschool Promise Tuition Assistance.
- 4) Exceptional circumstances may be considered case by case through a waiver request submitted to the Preschool Promise staff.
- 5) For families who currently are above 130% of the Federal Poverty Level and also receiving Publicly Funded Child Care, please see Table 1a.
